

Editor's Desk

- Does this topic fit with the Journal's focus?
- Are there gross issues of quality or design that make it not worth sending for review?
 - if either of these issues are a problem the article may be rejected with further review

Editor's Desk

- Editor may send to Deputy / Associate Editor
- Reviewers selected and invited to review
- Once reviews completed they are viewed by Editor and decision made
 - Accept
 - Reject
 - Accept pending suitable revision
 - Reject with encouragement to resubmit
 - Further peer review


Post Editorial Final Acceptance

- Sent to copy editor
 - Looks for areas that are unclear (ambiguous, omissions, contradictions)
 - Corrects syntax, grammar
- mprove readability
- Set to Journal Template

Post Editorial Final Acceptance

- Galley sent to Author for approval

 Approval of changes made by copy edit and questions requiring clarification
- Final Copy editor review
 - Marks up manuscript to guide printer
- Sent to printer
 - Hard copy / electronic posting



Overview

- Manuscript processing is a complex, multistep process
- To facilitate the process and improve chances of acceptance authors must adhere scrupulously to Journal requirements
- Editors and reviewers are volunteers who donate their time
