





WHY SHOULD YOU CAREFULLY CONSTRUCT YOUR PARAGRAPHS?

- Presents your information in an organized manner
- Enables you to clearly convey your message
- Helps your readers understand, and enjoy, reading your work



HOW DO YOU CREATE A PARAGRAPH?

- Write a clear topic sentence
- Include one main idea per paragraph
- Support your main idea with content
- End with a concluding sentence or a sentence that transitions to the next paragraph




WHY IS GRAMMAR IMPORTANT?


- Provides structure and meaning to language

- Allows individuals to communicate and understand each other


